You are hereby petitioned to prohibit the running at large, sheep, goats, and hogs in the following described tracks of land in Sabine County, to wit:

1st track: Beginning in center of Highway U. S. 96 at the North East corner of the C. M. McClelland Track. Thence West to the North West Corner; thence South to the South West corner. Thence East to West line of Highway U. S. 96. Thence South to Pompanaugh Creek.

2nd Track: Beginning where west line of U. S. Highway 96 crosses Pompanaugh Creek. Thence down said Creek to the North west corner of the C. M. McClelland Track. Thence South to the South West corner. Thence East to the South West Corner. Thence East to line between U. S. Highway 96 and Santa Fe Railroad. Thence North to Pompanaugh Creek.
