Hog Law Petition

HEMPHILL, TEXAS.

January 13th, 1948.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned, constituting a majority of the owners of the hereinafter described lands, wherein there are residing less than twenty freeholders, which lands adjoin territory over which a stock law now prevails, and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands in said stock law territory, and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats, to include such lands, said lands so requested to be included in said stock law being described in two tract as follows:

FIRST TRACT: Beginning at the N. W. corner of the original S.N. McClelland 100 acre tract; thence S 14 W 360 yrs to corner in the west line of said 100 acre tract, being W. W. Defee's N. W. corner; thence S 75 E with Defee's north line to the center of U. S. Highway No. 96; thence north along the center line of U. S. Highway No. 96 to the north line of the original S. N. McClelland 100 acres; thence N 75 W with said north line to the place of beginning

SECOND TRACT: Beginning at the S. W. corner of the S.N. McClelland 100 acre tract and the N. W. corner of what is known as the Print Bell tract in the east line of the Walter Bell 143 acres; thence N 14 1/2 E 331 yrs to the Popano creek; thence up said creek to the east line of the right of way of the G. C. & S. F. Ry. Co.; thence southerly with the east right of way line of said G. C. & S. F. Ry Co. to the point where said line crosses the south line of the S.N. McClelland 100 acres; thence N 75-3/4 W with said south line of said 100 acre tract to the place of beginning. Both of said tracts being situated in Sabine County, Texas.
