and passed the following order:

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS that the County Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed Sabine County Road District Bonds, on April 1, 1948, at the office of the State Treasurer, Austin, Texas;

- \$2,00.00 SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS ROAD DISTRICT NO. 1, 4% REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1941, dated April 1, 1941, due April 1, 1956, optional on any interest paying date, being bonds Numbers 22 and 23 in denomination of \$1000 each, and being part of an original issue of \$25,00 bonds
- \$3,000.00 SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, ROAD DISTRICT NO. 4, 4% REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1941 dated April 1, 1941 due April 1, 1956, optional on any interest paying date, being Bonds Number 4, 5 and 6, in denomination of \$1000 each, and being part of an original issue of \$34,00 bonds.
- \$4,000.00 SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, ROAD DISTRICT NO 5, 4% REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1941, dated April 1, 1941, due April 1, 1956, optional on any interest paying date, being Bonds Numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4, in denomination of \$1000 each, part of an original issue of \$11,000 bonds.
- \$1,000.00 SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, ROAD DISTRICT NO. 6, 4% REFUNDING BOND, SERIES 1941, dated April 1, 1941, due April 1, 1956, being Bond Number 2, in denomination of \$1000, part of an original issue of \$10,000 bonds.
- \$1,500.00 SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, ROAD DISTRICT No. 12, 4% REFUNDING BONDS, Series 1941, dated April 1, 1941 due April 1, 1956, optional on any interest paying date, being Bonds Number 7, 8 and 9, in denomination of \$500.00 each, part of an original issue of \$9500 bonds.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner E. C. Smith and seconded by Commissioner G. B. Conn that it be passed and upon the question being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners Conn, Smith, Thomas and Vickers voting AYE: and no one voting NO.
