

The Honorable Commissioners Court met in regular session at the regular meeting place, Monday, May 24, 1948, the following members were present; Chas. Forse County Judge, G. B. Conn, Comm. Prec. #1, E. C. Smith, Comm. Prec. #2, J. R. Thomas Comm. Prec 3, H. J. Vickers, Comm. Prec. #4.

On motion of H. J. Vickers & Seconded by G. B. Conn it was unanimously ordered by the Court that a Warrant be issued in the amount of \$1657.84 payable to Berry Brothers Machinery Co. on May 1, 1949 & a Warrant in the amount of \$1757.31 to Berry Brothers Machinery Co. Payable May 1, 1950. Warrants to be made payable out of the R. & B. Special Fund Prec. # 4.

On motion of G;B. Conn & Seconded by H. J. Vickers it was unanimously carried by the Commissioners Court that the City of Hemphill be given the right to lay pipe line on the right of way owned by Sabine County down the Fairdale Road to the Main Pipe line owned by the Tennessee Gas & Trans. Co. an approximate distance of 5 miles . In return the City of Hemphill agrees to leave the road in as good repair as they find it in at the time of construction of the line.
