ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT
AGREEING TO FURNISH RIGHT*OF* WAY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, in _____ session on this, the _____ dat of _____ 19____, that the Texas Highway Department will order a location made on Highway No. S, 103, from the Sabine-San Augustine County Line to State Highway 21 near Milam provided Sabine County, through its Commissioners' Court, agrees and obligates itself before location is made to fulfill the

the following requirements, on location approved by the Texas Highway Department, without cost to the State: (1) Provided clear title to the following, with standing timber: a minimum of 120 foot right-of-way, lands for borrow sources, and right-of-way for such drainage facilities as may be required, such title to be in the name of the State of Texas; (2) remove all obstructions and encroachments except standing timber; and (3) do the fencing

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT Sabine County, acting herein by and through its Commissioners' Court, agrees and obligates itself, before location is made, to fulfill the following requirements at its own expense and without recourse on the State for any costs or other obligations incurred thereby:

(1) Provide clear title to the following, with standing timber: a minimum of 120 foot right-of-way, lands for borrow sources, and right-of-way for such drainage facilities as may be required, such title to be in the name of the State of Texas.

(2) Remove all obstructions and encroachments except standing timber; and

(3) Do the fencing;

on Highway No. S. 103, from the Sabine-San Augustine County Line to State Highway 21 near Milam on location approved by the Texas Highway Department.
