and passed the following order:

There came on for consideration the extending of the maturity of certain bonds of Road District No. 13, which have matured. It appears that Bond No. 3 for \$500.00 was due March 9, 1940, and that Bond No. 4 for \$500.00 was due March 9, 1945, and that the maturity dates thereof should be extended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that in consideration of the holders of the above bonds having delayed requiring payment as originally due, Sabine County Road District No. 13 does hereby acknowledge the obligations and hereby orders that the maturity dated thereof be extended and said bonds be made to mature on March 9, 1949.

The above order having been read, it was moved by Commissioner H.J. Vickers and seconded by Commissioner E.C. Smith that it be passed, and upon the motion being called it was unanimously passed, with Commissioners Conn, Smith, Thomas and Vickers voting AYE and no one voting NO.
