To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County , Texas

Sirs:

I, R. L. Goo ck of Sabine Co. Texas own and operate the following described farm lands lying and being situated in Sabine County, Texas to-wit:
1st tract being 50 acres of the Sion Smith League, Beginning on the south boundary line of the Sion Smith league at the S.E. corner of the survey made for John C. Beckcum.

stake from which a post oak 14 ins brs N 57 W 1 vrs and a pine 24 ins brs N 40 E 7 vrs; thence N 35 E with the east line of said 100 acres 820 vrs. to its N E corner; stake from which a black oak 14 ins brs. N 73 W 4 vrs; thence S 57 E 348 vrs to stake for corner; thence S. 35 W 820 vrs to the south line of said Sion Smith league stake from which a hickory 16 ins brs S 29 E 10 vrs and an ash 12 ins brs N 36 E 4 vrs; thence N 57 W with the south line of said league 348 vrs to the place of beginning, containing 50 acres of land.

Second tract

Being 50 acres of the Sion Smith League, beginning at N E corner of a 50 acre tract made for R.S. Beckcum , thence S 35 W 820 vrs to the South east corner of said 50 acre tract stake in south boundry line of said league, from which a hickory 16 ins brs S 29 E 10 vrs and a ash 12 ins brs N 36 E 4 vrs; thence S 58 E with said south boundary line 300 vrs to the S W corner of the L.C. Whittlesey 177 acre, from which a pine 20 ins brs S 70 E 1 vrs an white oak 15 ins brs S 33 W 5 vrs; thence N 35 E with the west boundary line of said 177 acres 820 vrs to another corner of same, a stake from which a white oak 15 ins brs S 41 E 3 vrs an whiteoak 10 ins brs N 14 E 4 vrs; thence N 24 E 274 vrs to a stake for corner; thence S 76 W 377 vrs to the place of beginning, containing 50 acres of land.

The North boundary line of the above described land is the South boundary line of the stocklaw area.

I ask the Court to include my farm in the stock law area.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned, constituting at least twenty free -holders of the hereinafter described subdivision of Sabine County, Texas , do hereby petition your honorable body to order an election to be held in said subdivision on some day named by you for the purpose of enabling the free-holders of such subdivision to determine whether hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large in said subdivision, the boundaries of said subdivision being as follows:

BEGINNING at the point where the Sabine and Jasper County line crosses the south line of the Donald McDonald League; thence N 75 W to the point where the south line of said McDonald League crosses the Sabine and San Augustine county line; thence Northwest with said county line to the point where said county line crosses the west line of the Donald McDonald League; thence N 15 E with the west line of said McDonald League to the Northwest corner of said league; thence S 75 E with the north line of said McDonald League to the Bear Creek; thence up Bear Creek with its meanders to the mouth of Devil's Ford Creek; thence up Devil's Ford Creek with its meanders to the point where said creek crossed the North or Northeast line of the Samuel Nelson Survey; thence S 49 E with the north or northeast line of the Nelson Survey and the north or northeast line of the M. Cummings League to the N.E. corner of said Cummings League on the McKim south league line; thence S 52 west with the Cummings East line to the Sabine and Jasper County line; thence westerly,

about S 79 W with said County line to the place of beginning.
