Gentlemen;

The City of Hemphill, Texas proposes to construct a natural gas system to serve Hemphill and some areas immediately outside the present City Limits. The source of supply of natural gas is to be from the Tennessee Gas Transmission Corporation 24" line at a point where this line crosses the Fairdale Road about five <sup>miles</sup> east of Hemphill.

From this point, the City proposes to construct a 3" natural gas transmission line to town along the Fairdale Road.

In order to construct the transmission line to Hemphill and the distribution mains to those areas outside the City Limits it will be necessary to install these lines on county roads.

Your approval and permission is respectfully requested to install natural gas transmission and distribution lines on county road right-of-ways in a manner stipulated by the plans and specifications of the City's Professional Engineers as required to serve the people with natural gas facilities.
