The Honorable Commissioners' Court met at the regular meeting place Monday, August 22, 1949 which the following members present, to-wit: O.A. Beauchamp, County Judge, G.B. Conn, Comm. Prec. #1, E.C. Smith, Comm. Prec. #2, J.R. Thomas, Comm. Prec. #3, H.J. Vickers, Comm. Prec. #4, and Floyd Smith, County Clerk.

On motion of G. B. Conn and seconded by J.R. Thomas, it was unanimously ordered that the title to 1/3 of an acre of land at the site of the old school building be deeded back to Brookeland Independent School District.

The Petior of Mr. Jeff Thomas and other from Brookeland and Pineland to redistrict the commissioner's precincts was read and discussed. On motion of G.B. Conn and seconded by H.J. Vickers it was ordered that Mr. J.H. Minton make a tentative map of the proposed new commissioner's precincts ^{so} that the Court could make a study of the proposal. With the stipulation that this does not commit the court to make any changes whatever.

On motion of H.J. Vickers and seconded by J.R. Thomas it was ordered that the salary of G.W. Russell, Jr. be set at \$10.00 per month effective Sept. 1, 1949.
