ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT AGREEING TO
FURNISH RIGHT-OF-WAY

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF SABINE WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, in regular session on this the 27th day of March, 1950, that the Texas Highway Department was designated ^a farm to Market Road from proposed location of State Highway No. 103, near Rosevine to State Highway No. 184, 2 miles west of Hemphill, a distance of approximately 8.2 miles and subject to the condition that Sabine County will furnish all required right-of-way free of cost to the State.

It is Therefore, Ordered That Sabine County, acting herein by and through Commissioners' Court accepts the designation as made by the Highway Department and agrees to furnish the required Right-of-way free of cost to the State as stipulated in the designation order.
