COUNTY OF SABINE § WHEREAS, on the 24 day of April, 1950, a petition signed by twenty-five (25) legally qualified voters of Sexton Common School District No. 24 of Sabine County, Texas, was presented to me praying for an election to be held in said District to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified voters of said District desire that Sexton Common School District No. 24, of Sabine County, Texas shall be consolidated with Shelbyville Rural High School District No. 41, of Shelby County, Texas, for school purposes; and,

It appearing that said petition bears more than the requisite number of signatures of legally qualified voters of said District and is in every respect in conformity with the law; and,

It appearing that Sexton Common School District No. 24 of Sabine County, Texas, and Shelbyville Rural High School District No. 41, of Shelby County, Texas, have been properly established and created, and are legally and validly existing school districts, and are contiguous school districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O.A. BEAUCHAMP, in my official capacity as County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby order an election be held at the Sexton Schoolhouse Building in Sexton Common School District No. 24 of Sabine County, Texas, on the 20th day of May, 1950, to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified voters of said District desire that Sexton Common School District No. 24 of Sabine County, Texas, shall be consolidated with Shelbyville Rural High School District No. 41 of Shelby County, Texas, for school purposes.

Said election shall be held under the provisions of Title 49, Chapter 13 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas of 1925, and the polls for such election shall be opened at 8 A.M. and closed at 6 P.M. C. E. Arnold is hereby appointed as presiding officer of such election, with Mrs. R. T. Smith and Pete Waldrop as his assistants, and he shall have the authority to name such clerks as may be necessary to conduct the election, and such officers shall, within five days after said election has been held, make due returns of such election to the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County Texas, as required by law.

All persons who are legally qualified voters of Sabine County, Texas, residing within said District, shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all such voters desiring to vote for the consolidation of Said Sexton Common School District No. 24, of Sabine County, Texas, with Shelbyville Rural High School District No. 41 of Shelby County, Texas, shall have written or printed on their ballots the words:

"FOR CONSOLIDATION"

And those who are opposed to the consolidation of said Sexton Common School District No. 24, of Sabine County, Texas, with Shelbyville Rural High School District No. 41 of Shelby County, Texas, shall have written or printed on their ballots the words:

"AGAINST CONSOLIDATION"

Notice of said election shall be given by posting notices thereof in three (3) public places in said District at least twenty (20) days prior to the date of such election.
