There came before the Court for consideration the request of Deep East Texas Electric Cooperative for permission to make use of that portion of Gambatti Street which adjoins Block No. 45 of the town of Bronson, Texas, on the north end which portion of said street lies between Block No. 45 and the unnumbered out lot of the town of Bronson, Texas, lying north of Block No. 45 for the erection and maintenance of an electric substation on said property. The Court having considered the application, upon motion made by Commissioner H.J. Vickers and seconded by Commissioner G.B. Conn and carried by a vote of 4 to 0 it is ordered that the Deep East Texas Electric Cooperative be permitted to erect on the above portion of Gambatti Street an electric substation to be used by them in connection with the operation and maintenance of high voltage transmission line from San Augustine to Bronson, Texas.

And the County Clerk is ordered to deliver to Deep East Texas Electric Cooperation a Certified copy of this order.

You are hereby notified that on the 26th day of June, A.D. 1950, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, upon the written request of C.C. Rice and D.B. Speights that they be relieved as sureties upon your official Bond as Sheriff of Sabine County, Texas, made and entered its order releasing the said C.C. Rice and D.B. OATH OF BOARD

When a Commissioners' Court convenes as a board of equalization, before considering the subject of equalization of property values for the purposes of taxation, each member of the court, including the County Judge shall take and subscribe the following oath: " I, O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge; G.B. Conn, Comm. Precinct #1; E.C. Smith, Comm. Precinct #2; J.R. Thomas, Comm. Precinct #3; and H.J. Vickers, Comm. Precinct #4; members of the board of equalization of Sabine County, for the year A.D. 1950, hereby solemnly swear that, in the performance of my duties as a member of such board for said year I will not vote to allow any taxable property to stand assessed on the tax rolls of said County for said year at any sum which I believe to be less than its true and market value. Or, if it has no market value, then its real value; that I will faithfully endeavor and as a member of said board will move to have each item of taxable property which I believe to be assessed for said year at less than its true and market value or real value, raised on the tax rolls to what I believe to be its true cash market value if it has a market value, and if not, then to its real value; and that I will faithfully endeavor to have the assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation within said county stand upon the tax rolls of said county for said year at its true cash market value, or if it has no market value, then its true cash market value, or if it has no market value, then its real value. I further solemnly swear that I have read and understand the provisions contained in the Constitution and laws of this state relative to the valuation of taxable property, and that I will faithfully perform all the duties required of me under the constitution and laws of this state.
