ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT AGREEING TO FURNISH RIGHT-OF-WAY

COUNTY OF SABINE | WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, in regular session on this the 13th day of June, 1951, that the Texas Highway Department has designated a farm to Market Road from State 21, 4.0 miles East of Milam Southeast to road intersection, a distance of approximately 4.3 miles.

From State 87, 5.0 miles North of Milam Northeast to road intersection, a distance of approximately 3.6 miles, and subject to the condition that Sabine County will furnish all required Right-of-Way free of cost to the State.

It is therefore Ordered that Sabine County, acting herein by and through Commissioners' Court, accepts the designation as made by the highway Department and agrees to furnish the required Right-of-Way free of cost to the State as stipulated in the designation order.
