Commissioner, John R. Thomas made the motion that "In view of the fact that the County Board of Education, by resolution, has recommended the appointment of R.B. Sewell, Jr., I move that R.B. Sewell Jr. be appointed to serve as County Superintendent until the next General election." The motion was seconded by Commissioner Leon McDaniel.

The following were absent: None; constituting a quorum and among other proceedings had by the board was the following: There came on to be considered the viewing the possibilities for replacing the County superintendent, resigned;

Whereas, the resignation of Herman E. King as County Superintendent and its acceptance effective as of Midnight Friday night August 31, 1951, makes imperative that the office be filled temporarily by appointment;

Whereas, the County Court has shown praiseworthy consideration of the County Board and the problems involved as shown in joint meeting of the Court and the County Board;

Whereas, the Court has requested that the County Board recommend a replacement for the County Superintendent, if possible that in the Board's judgment would measure up to the challenge of the days ahead;

Whereas, the Board would recommend a qualified individual, professional in his attitude and cooperative in his thinking, willing to carry out the policies of the present administration to stabilize our education system;

Whereas the qualifications, background, apparent willingness to work and the friendly cooperative attitude of Bob Sewell meet with the approval of the Board.

Therefore be it resolved that the County Board of School Trustees of Sabine County appreciate the consideration of the County Court toward the Board and the problems of Education, that the Board recommends to the Commissioners Court the appointment of Bob Sewell as County Supt. of Public Instruction to serve until next general election.

The resolution being read it was moved and seconded that the same do pass, whereupon the question being called for the resolution passed unanimously.
