Gibbons survey, Abstract No. 107; thence N. 45 W. with Mason's West line and Gibbon's east line to another corner of said Mason League and also one of the J.W. Gibbons corners; thence N. 3 W. with Mason's west league line to the N.W. corner of said James Mason League on the south line of the G.H. Love Survey, Abstract No. 156; thence with said Love's line S. 51 W. to the South or Southeast corner of said G.H. Love Survey; thence N. 34 W. with Love's west line to its west or northwest corner; thence S. 51 W. with the Southeast line of the Theo Harris Survey, to the South corner of said Harris Survey; thence N. 65 W. with Theo Harris' South line to the Southwest corner of said Harris survey on the East line of the Wm. Defee Survey, Abstract No. 86; thence N. 27 E. with Defee's East line to the N.E. corner of said Defee Survey in the South line of the Richard Slaughter League; thence with Slaughter's South line and Defee's north line N. 65 W. to the S.W. corner of the Richard Slaughter League and the N.W. corner of said Wm. Beginning at the point where the Sabine and San Augustine County, line crosses the south boundary line of the William Roberts League; thence easterly with the south line of said Roberts League to the west boundary line of the William Isaacs League; thence northerly with said Isaacs West league line to the Donahoe Creek; thence down said Donahoe creek with its meanders to the west line of the S.M. Hennigan home place; thence south with Hennigan's west line to his S.W. corner; thence easterly with the South line of the Hennigan home place and the M. Wright home place; thence Northerly with said Wright east line to the Donahoe Creek; thence down Donahoe Creek with its meanders to the Tebo Creek and thence down Tebo Creek with its meanders to the east line of the William Isaacs League; thence Northerly with the east line of said Isaacs League to the N.W. corner of the Joseph Mott League; thence Northerly with said Isaac's East line to the S.W. corner of the Naomi Mackey League; thence easterly with Mackey's South line to the Pologocho Creek; thence up said Pologocho creek with its meanders to the west line of the said Naomi Mackey League; thence northerly with Mackey's west line to Mackey's N.W. corner thence easterly with Mackey's North line and Willie Murphy's line to the most eastern corner of the Willis Murphy League; thence Northerly with Murphy's east line to Murphy's most northeast corner; thence westerly and southwesterly with Murphy's North league line to the Sabine and San Augustine County line; thence Southwesterly and southerly with said County line to the place of beginning.
