The returns of an Election held on the 13th day of November, A.D. 1951 for the purpose of electing a Representative for District 11 to fill the unexpired term were canvassed with the following results found:

G. V. Gooch received 88 votes  
 F. L. Beauchamp received 289 votes  
 Mrs. Tommie Wilkinson Lott received 82 votes  
 Theo Boyette received 76 votes.

The returns of the Constitutional Amendments Election held November 13, 1951, were canvassed and the following results were found:
