ORDER DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION--SUB-DIVISION

HOGS, SHEEP & GOATS--ART. 6930

On this 28 day of April, 1952, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 19th day of April, 1952, at Pineland, in a sub-division of Sabine County, Texas, for the purpose of enabling the freeholders of said sub-division to determine whether Hogs, Sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large in said sub-division.

And it appearing from said returns, duly and lawfully made, that there were cast at said election 61 votes, of which number 39 votes were cast "For the Stock Law," and 22 votes were cast "Against the Stock Law," IT IS THEREFORE FOUND AND DECLARED, AND SO ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE County, Texas, that a majority of the voters voting at said election voted in favor of the stock law.

PROCLAMATION OF RESULTS OF STOCK LAW ELECTION SUB-DIVISION C, COUNTY

HOGS, SHEEP AND GOATS--ART. 6930

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF SABINE || WHEREAS, an election was held on the 19 day of April, 1952, in Pineland, a sub-division of Sabine County, Texas, for the purpose of enabligh the freeholders of said sub-division to determine whether Hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large in said sub-division and

WHEREAS, said returns were opened, tabulated and counted by the Commissioners Court of said County in the manner as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Votes cast at such election were "For the Stock Law."

I, therefore, now, in my capacity as County Judge of said County, issue this proclamation declaring that the majority of the votes cast at said election were "For the Stock Law," and that after the expiration of thirty days from the date of this proclamation, it shall be unlawful to pe mit to run at large within the sub-division described as follows:

Beginning at the point where the North line of the James A. Curry League intersects or crosses the east line of the Larkin Groce League at the South west corner of Section No. 37 T. & N. O. Ry. Co; thence Northerly with the east line of the Larkin Groce League, to the north east corner of Block No. 36, of the L. F. Bacon Subdivision, in the West boundary of said T. & N. O. Section 37; thence westerly with the north line of Blocks Nos. 36 and 35 of said Bacon Subdivision to the northeast corner of Block No. 34, of said Bacon Subdivision; thence Southerly with the east line of said Block No. 34, to its S. E. corner; thence westerly with the South line of said Block No. 34, to its S. W. Corner; thence northerly with the west line of said Block No. 34, to the north east corner of Block No. 33 of said Bacon Subdivision; thence West-erly with the north line of said Block No. 33, to the S. E. corner of Block No. 29 of said Bacon subdivision; thence northerly with the east line of said Block No. 29, to the N. E. corner of Block No. 29, and being the most easterly S. E. corner of the City of Pineland, Texas; thence with east line of the City of Pineland, N. 14-1/4 E. 256 vrs. and N. 13 E. 727 vrs. to corner in the N. B. line of the Larkin Groce League in the south line of a 10 acre tract on the J. W. Cadwell Survey; thence N. 77 W. with Groce's N. B. line to the S. W. corner of said 10 acre tract; thence with the west line of said 10 acre tract N. 35 E. 230 vrs. to corner in the South line of the Martin Whitehead survey; thence N. 55 W. to the Southwest corner of said Whitehead survey; thence N. 81 W. 670 vrs. to the Southeast corner of the J. W. Jordan Survey; thence N. 8 E. with Jordan's East line to corner in the bank of a branch, the south east corner of the Jim Reid 10 acres on the Jordan survey; thence westerly with the meanders of said branch to the south west corner of said Reid 10 acres; thence up said branch or creek with its mean-ders to where said creek crosses the north line of the J. W. Jordan Survey;

Thence N. 31 W. with Jordan North line to the northwest corner of said Jordan Survey; thence N. 82 W. 402 vrs. to the M. E. corner of the Nicholas Jacks Survey; thence S. 9 W. 1055 vrs. to the S. E. corner of said Jacks Survey in the North line of the Larkin Groce Survey; thence N. 77 W. with Groce's north line 150 vrs. to the northeast corner of Block No. 1 of L. F. Bacon Subdivision, being the northwest corner of the original town of Pineland; thence S. 13 W. with the west line of the original town of Pineland, to the point where said west line intersects the farm-to-market highway No. 1; thence Westerly with the said meanders of said farm-to-market highway to its intersection with U. S. Highway No. 96; thence northerly with said U. S. Highway No. 96, to the point where said highway crosses the west line of the W. F. Pate Survey; thence North 21 East with the West line of said Pate Survey to its N. W. corner; thence S. 69 E. with said Pate's North line to the S. W. corner of T. & N. O. Ry. Co. Sec. No. 21, being the S. W. corner of Block No. 88 of the L. F. Bacon Subdivision; thence North 9 East with the west

line of said section 21 to the north west corner of said Block No. 88; thence N. 85 E. with the North line of Blocks Nos. 88, 87, and 86 to the Southwest corner of the Drucilla Jacks Survey; thence N. 5 W. with the west line of said Jacks Survey to the N.W. corner of the Dora Mangum tract of 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres; thence easterly with the north line of said Mangum tract to the center of the old State Highway No. 8; thence Northerly with the center of old said State Highway No. 8 to the South line of the John Gilbert League; thence North 85 East with the South line of the John Gilbert League and the South line of the J.H. Lamberth Survey to the N.E. corner of the Ed Myer Survey, Abstract No. 475; thence S. 5 E. with the east line of said Meyer survey to the northwest line of the John Moore League, Abstract No. 41; thence N. 35 E. to the north corner of the John Moore League; thence S. 55 E. with said John Moore north east line to his east corner; thence S. 35 W. with said John Moore's South east line to the south west or west corner of the Wm. Cain, survey; thence S. 55 E. with Wm. Cain's South line to the extreme east corner of T. & N.O. Section No. 40; thence S. 35 W. with the east line of said Section No. 40 to the north line of the J.A. Curry League; thence S. 69 W. with the North line of said J.A. Curry League to the place of beginning. ANY HOGS, SHEEP AND GOATS.

This proclamation shall be posted at the Courthouse door of said county.
