

The Honorable Commissioners' Court met at its regular meeting place Monday, September 22, 1952, with the following members present: O.A. Beauchamp, County Judge; W.L. Glover, Commissioner, Precinct #1; Mrs. Vada McDaniel, Comm. Precinct #2; J.R. Thomas, Comm. Precinct #3 and H.J. Vickers, Comm. Precinct #4; and Floyd Smith, County Clerk.

It has come to the attention of the Commissioners Court that there is now in the hands of the Board of County and Road District Indebtedness, a balance over and above the amount necessary to service Sabine County Road indebtedness for the present fiscal year.

It is therefore the order of the Court that Hon. Joe Nelson, Chief Accountant of State Board of County and Road District Indebtedness be requested to forward ~~xxxxxx~~ ~~xxxxxx~~ such funds as will not be needed for the fiscal year to the Treasurer of Sabine County, Texas, for the use of the County for maintenance of its roads and bridges.

The Commissioners Court directed the County Treasurer to pay to the Texas State Highway Department \$7,611.13 in full settlement of the claims the Highway Department has filed against Sabine County.

The sale of an Allis Chalmers Tractor & scraper for \$200.00 to Mutt Glover was unanimously approved.

There being no other business we were adjourned.
