There came on for consideration State Highway Commission Minute No. 32797 dated October 21, 1952 designating a Farm-to-Market Road from State 87 in Hemphill East to Road intersection, a distance of approximately 5.1 miles in Sabine county, Texas, which designation was accepted in full by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas.

The Commissioners Court unanimously agreed that Sabine County would furnish all required right-of-way free of cost to the State.
