ORDER DECLARING INTENTION TO ISSUE
ROAD AND BRIDGE REFUNDING BONDS

THERE CAME ON TO BE CONSIDERED the matter of issuing \$30,000.00 Road and Bridge Refunding Bonds for the purpose of refunding an equal amount of Road Machinery Warrants of said County, and it appears to the best interest of Sabine County and to its citizens and taxpayers to do so.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, T E X A S:

That it is the intention of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, on the 27th day of July, 1953, to pass all necessary orders to provide for the issuance of Sabine County Road and Bridge Refunding Bonds in the maximum amount of \$30,000.00, bearing interest at the rate of not exceeding 4% per annum with maximum maturity date not to exceed 15 years from their date, for the purpose of refunding an equal amount of Sabine County 4% Road Machinery Warrants; and the County Judge is hereby authorized and directed to cause appropriate notice to be published accordingly.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner W. T. Love and seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith that it be passed, and upon the question's being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners BYLEY, LOVE, LOUT and SMITH voting AYE: and no one voting NO.
