

The Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session at the regular meeting place in the Court House, Hemphill, Texas, on November 9, 1953 with all members present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. H. Byley, Commr. Precinct #1, W. T. Love, Commr. Precinct #2, Paul Lout, Commr. Precinct #3, Earl Smith, Commr. Precinct #4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Accounts were allowed as shown by "Minutes of Accounts Allowed."

The following petition was presented to the Court:

March 6, 1953

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

WE, the undersigned, constituting a majority of the owners of the hereinafter

described lands in which there are less than twenty free holders, and which lands adjoin lands over which a stock law now prevails and in which hogs, sheep and goats are forbidden to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands or territory in said stock law territory and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats to such territory, which is described as follows:

BEGINNING at the S. W. corner of the W. E. Clegg 100 acre tract, same being the S. E. corner of the Owen Lindsey Survey and in the north line of the Thomas Lindsey survey; THENCE N. 9 E. 756 vrs. with Clegg's west line to the S. E. corner of the J. D. Ansley 54 acre tract; THENCE N. 81 W. 450 vrs. to the S. W. corner of said Ansley's 54 acre tract; THENCE N. 9 E. 400 vrs. to an internal corner of said Ansley tract; THENCE N. 81 W. 150 vrs. to Ansley's most northerly S. W. Corner; THENCE S. 9 W. 742 vrs. with the east line of a 134-1/2 acre tract to the S. E. corner of said 134-1/2 acre tract; THENCE N. 81 W. 850 vrs. to corner on the east line of the G. A. Gary 100 acre tract; THENCE S. 9 W. with Gary's east line to the north line of the Thomas Lindsey Survey; THENCE N. 81 W. with the north line of said Thomas Lindsey Survey to the east corner of a 2.6 acre tract known as the G. H. Sale tract; THENCE N. 68 W. with the north line of said 2.6 acre tract 343 vrs. to the N. W. corner of said 2.6 acre tract; THENCE S. 9 W. with the west line of said 2.6 acres and the west line of said Thomas Lindsey Survey to the N. W. corner of the Ella Meador 34 acres now owned by Joe Jacks; Thence east with the north line of said 34 acres to its northeast corner; THENCE south with the east line of said Meador 34 acres to its S. E. corner; THENCE westerly with the south line of Meador's 34 acres to its S. W. corner in the west line of said Thomas Lindsey Survey; THENCE S. 9 W. with the west line of said Thomas Lindsey Survey to its S. W. corner; THENCE S. 81 E. with the south line of the Thomas Lindsey Survey to the S. E. Corner of the W. J. Barlow 32 acres; THENCE N. 9 E. about 683 vrs. with the west line of Block 56 and 54 of the L. F. Bacon subdivision to an internal corner of Block No. 54 of the Bacon subdivision, being also the N. E. corner of the C. W. Cunningham 8 acres; THENCE N. 81 W. at 43 vrs. pass the S. E. corner of 160 acres known as the C. A. Wood 160 acres and continuing the same course with the south line of said C. A. Wood tract to the Bear Creek; THENCE up Bear Creek with its meanders to the north line of the Thomas Lindsey Survey; THENCE S. 81 E. with the north line of said Thomas Lindsey Survey to the place of beginning.
