Accounts were allowed as shown by "Minutes of Accounts Allowed."

The "Hog Law Petition" presented to the Court on November 9, 1953, was on this date considered by the Court.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by a majority of the owners of the land therein described, and that no stock law now exists in said territory adjoins lands in which a stock law now prevails, and in which hogs, sheep and goats are forbidden to run at large;

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner H. H. Byley and seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout, the Vote being 4 for and O against, the petition was granted unanimously.

It is ordered by the Court that said petition be in all things granted and that the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats is hereby extended to include such territory and such territory is hereby declared to be included in territory wherein hogs, sheep and goats are forbidden to run at large, and from and after this date it shall be unlawful for hogs, sheep and goats to run at large in the territory described in the petition presented to the Court on November 9, 1953.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
