The Court unanimously passed the following order: To use the same breakdown on the monthly reports, except to take approximately 4/28th from current tax of Officers Salary Fund and add to General County in redemption.

On motion by W. T. Love, Commr. Prec. #2 and seconded by H. H. Byley, Commr. Prec. #1 it was unanimously voted that the salary of J. M. Crocker, Justice of the Peace, Prec. # , be raised \$5 per month to take care of rent on his office in Pineland.
