

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met at the regular meeting place in the office of the County Judge in Hemphill in regular session on August 8, 1955 with all the members of the Court present, to-wit: W. G. Brewton, County Judge, H. H. Byley, Commr. Prect. #1, W. T. Love, Commr. Prect. #2, Paul Lout, Commr. Prect. 3, Earl Smith, Commr. Prect. #4 and Kyle D. Walker Clerk of the Court, and the following absent: W. T. Love.

Accounts were allowed by the Court as are shown by the Minutes of Accounts Allowed.

It was unanimously ordered by the Court that the County Judge request <sup>that</sup> the Lateral Road money be sent at the States earliest convenience.

ORDER DECLARING RESULTS

There came on to be considered; the returns to an election held in said County on the 25 day of July, 1955, to determine whether or not the following classes of animals to-wit: hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large in the following subdivision to-wit:

BEGINNING at the point where the Sabine and Jasper County line crosses the south boundary line of the Donald McDonald League; Thence Westerly with said County line to the intersections of the Sabine, Jasper and San Augustine Counties lines; THENCE in a Northerly direction following and with the meanders of the County line between Sabine County and San Augustine County to the South line of the Ben Lindsey League; THENCE S 75 E with the South line of the Ben Lindsey League and the South line of the Larkin Groce League to the Center of the U. S. Highway No. 96; THENCE Southerly with the center of said highway to the point where said highway crosses Popano Creek, being the

first creek on said highway South of the Larkin Groce South line; THENCE up said Popano' creek with its meanders to the South line of the G. W. Nerren original 125 acre tract on the A. E. C. Johnson and Samuel Nelson Surveys; THENCE East with the South line of said Nerren 125 acre tract to the West or Northwest line of the Samuel Nelson Survey; THENCE N. 41 E with the Nelson N. W. line and the Jasper McKim Northwest line to the North Corner of the Jasper McKim League in the West of Southwest line of the J. A. Curry Survey; THENCE S. 49 E with the South or Southwest line of the Curry Survey and the North or Northwest line of the Jasper McKim Survey to the East or Southeast corner of the Jasper McKim Survey; THENCE S 41 W with the East or Southeast line of the Jasper McKim Survey to the Sabine and Newton County line; THENCE Westerly with the Sabine and Newton County line to the intersection of the Jasper and Newton County line with the Sabine and Newton County line and continuing in a westerly direction with the Sabine and Jasper County line to the place of BEGINNING. AND it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 70 valid and legal votes, of which number there were cast:

FOR THE STOCK LAW 52 votes

AGAINST THE STOCK LAW 18 votes

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, DECLARED AND SO ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Sabine, County, Texas, that a majority of the freeholders and qualified voters in said subdivision voting at said elected voted for said proposition.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that same do pass. Thereupon, the question being called for, the following members of the Court voted AYE: Paul Lout, Earl Smith, H. H. Byley, \_\_\_\_\_, and the following voted NO: \_\_\_\_\_

#### PROCLAMATION

THE STATE OF TEXAS |

COUNTY OF SABINE |

WHEREAS, an election was duly and legally held in Sabine County, Texas, on the 25 day of July, 1955, to determine whether or not the following classes of animals, to-wit: hogs, sheep and goats shall be permitted to run at large in the following subdivision to-wit:

BEGINNING at the point where the Sabine and Jasper County line crosses the south boundary line of the Donald McDonald League; THENCE Westerly with said County line to the intersections of the Sabine, Jasper and San Augustine Counties lines; THENCE in a Northerly direction following and with the meanders of the County line between Sabine County and San Augustine County to the South line of the Ben Lindsey League; THENCE S 75 E with the South line of the Ben Lindsey League and the South line of the Larkin Groce League to the Center of the U. S. Highway No. 96; THENCE Southerly with the center of said highway to the point where said highway crosses Popano Creek, being the first creek on said highway South of the Larkin Groce South line; THENCE up said Popano Creek with its meanders to the South line of the G. W. Nerren original 125 acre tract on the A. E. C. Johnson and Samuel Nelson Surveys; THENCE East with the South line of said Nerren 125 acre tract to the West or Northwest line of the Samuel Nelson Survey; THENCE N. 41 E with the Nelson N. W. line and the Jasper McKim Northwest line to the North corner of the Jasper McKim League in the

West of Southwest line of the J. A. Curry Survey; THENCE S 49 E with the South or Southwest line of the Curry Survey and the North or Northwest line of the Jasper McKim Survey to East or Southeast corner of the Jasper McKim Survey; THENCE S 41 W with the East or Southeast line of the Jasper McKim Survey to the Sabine and Newton County line; THENCE WESTERLY with the Sabine and Newton County line to the intersection of the Jasper and Newton County line with the Sabine and Newton County line and continuing in a westerly direction with the Sabine and Jasper County line to the place of BEGINNING.

WHEREAS the returns of said election were duly and legally made and on the 8 day of Aug, 1955, the Commissioners' Court of said County considered the several returns and canvassed the same and by order duly entered declared that a majority of the freeholders and qualified voters in said subdivision, voting at said election, voted for said proposition;

NOW, therefore, I W. G. Brewton, in my capacity as County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby issue this proclamation declaring the result of said election.

That as found and declared by the above mentioned order of the Commissioners' Court of said County there were cast at said election 70 valid and legal votes of which number 52 votes were cast "FOR THE STOCK LAW" 18 and votes were cast "AGAINST THE STOCK LAW."

I hereby find and declare that a majority of the freeholders and qualified voters in said subdivision, voting at said election, voted for said proposition and that after the expiration of thirty days from the issuance of this proclamation it shall be unlawful to permit to run at large in said subdivision the following classes of animals to-wit, hogs, sheep and goats.

A copy of this proclamation shall be posted at the courthouse door of this county as provided by law.
