Byley, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, that the State Highway Commission be requested to proceed with the construction of the section of Farm Road 705 from the San Augustine-Sabine County line to the town of Brookeland, as designated, a distance of approximately 3.5 miles and that the construction of this project proceed in accordance with the terms of State Highway Commission Minute #36835 dated October 13, 1954 and accepted by the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, October 25, 1954.
