

The Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session at the Office of the County Judge in Hemphill, Texas, on June 11, 1956, with the following members present to-wit: W. G. Brewton, County Judge, W. T. Love, Commr. Precinct # 2, Paul Lout, Commr. Prec. #3, Earl Smith, Commr. Prec. #4 and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court, and H. H. Byley was absent.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the "Minutes of Accounts Allowed".

It was unanimously agreed by the Court that Mr. Zed Bridges be paid his Commission to date on the delinquent taxes he collected for the County.

The Court voted 2 to 1 to pay Deputy Sheriff, B. T. Woods, \$250.00 Salary and \$100 travel expense, per month, Paul Lout voting to pay him \$300 per month Salary and \$100 for travel expense.
