ORDER GIVING PERMISSION FOR GC&SF CROSSING ON SIX PUBLIC ROADS
BETWEEN BROWDELL AND PINELAND IN CONNECTION WITH MCGEE RESERVOIR

At a special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, held on November 9, 1956 at the regular meeting place of the Court at the Courthouse at Hemphill, Texas with all members present, and County Judge W. G. Brewton presiding, it was brought to the attention of the Court that Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company is desirous of relocating a line by crossing six public roads and constructing 1155 feet of road to permit closing the road crossing the relocated line near Remlig Cemetery in Sabine County between Browndell and Pineland, according to requests from the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army in connection with McGee Bend Reservoir, reference to maps filed with request is hereby given.

The Court having considered said request, and there appearing to be no objections to the request, it was moved by Commissioner Byley that the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas grant permission to the Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company to cross six public roads and construct 1155 feet of road to permit closing the road near Remlig Cemetery in Sabine County between Browndell and Pineland, with expense of relocating and crossing to be borne by the Railway Company, The Crossings being identified by Railway Company's survey stations 4768/36, 4779/88, 4797/73, 4912/04, 4974/52, 5021/71 and 5072/09.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner W. T. Love, and the following vote was noted:
