TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS.

I hereby request that you enter an order establishing as a public road with the right-of-way 66 feet wide with provision for actual clearing of a width of at least 30 feet. The present neighborhood road leaving State Highway No. 87 a short distance South of the North line of the Isaac Powell League and the South line of the J. W. Gibbons Survey, Abstract No. 107 and running in a Northwesterly and Westerly direction, a distance of approximately 195 yards to and passing a tract of land of 93,995 acres of said J. W. Givvons Survey owned by me and under contract of sale by me to the Veteran's Land Board of the State of Texas. This road has been used continuously by persons having occasion to travel it for the past 25 years. That portion of this road between State Highway No. 87 and my tract of land crosses lands owned by the U. S. Forest Service and by J. W. Minton and heither has any objection to same being designated and established as a public road.
