The Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session on November 24, 1958, at the office of the County Judge in Hemphill, Texas, with all the members of the Court present, to-wit: W. G.Brewton, Co. Judge, H. W. Wright, Commr. Precinct #1, W. T. Love, Commr. Prect. #2, Paul Lout, Commr. Prect. #3, Earl Smith, Commr. Prect. #4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the Minutes of Accounts Allowed.

Upon a motion by W. T. Love and seconded by H. W. Wright the court unamimously voted that Judge W.G.Brewton buy some furniture for the office of the County Clerk.

Upon motion by W. T. Love, Commr. Prect. #2 and seconded by H.W. Wright, Commr. Prect. #2, the court unanimously voted that the Clerk of the Court issue two time warrants on Precinct #3 totaling \$1,766.00. One time warrant totaling \$883.00, due April 15, 1959 and one time warrant totaling \$883,⁰⁰ due December 15, 1959. Also two time warrants on precinct #1, in the sum of \$1298.52 each, one due April 15, 1959 and one due April 15, 1960. The Court further ordered that one half of the Warrant previously issued on Precinct #4, in the amount of \$4548.30 be paid on Dec. 15, 1958 and the balance be paid on Dec. 15,1959. There being no further business, court adjourned.
