

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met in regular session on June 8, 1959 at the regular meeting place in Hemphill, with all members of the Court present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner Prec. #1, W. T. Love, Comm. Prec. #2 Paul Lout, Commr. Prec. #3, Earl Smith, Commr. Prec. #4 and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the "Minutes of Accounts Allowed". Upon Motion by W. T. Love and seconded by Earl Smith, all voting aye except Paul Lout, who voted NO, the court ordered a 5% salary cut on all county employees in the court house except the Janitor, Pete Allen, effective July 1, 1959. It was further ordered by the Court that \$8,000.00 be taken out of Government Forrest Check, and placed in General Funds, \$3,000.00 to be taken out of Precincts #2 and #4 and \$1,000.00 to be taken from Prec. 1 & 3. The Court agreed to raise the salary of R. L. Martin, J. P. Prec. #3, \$30.00 per month. This being all the business, Court adjourned.
