The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in Called Session on Aug. 29, 1959, at the regular meeting place of the Court in the Office of the County Judge with the following members of the Court present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commr. Prect. #1, W. T. Love, Commr. Prect. #2, and Earl Smith, Commr. Prect. #4 with Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the court.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the Minutes of Accounts Allowed.

Sheriff, Everett Smith, submitted his resignation as Sheriff of Sebine Co. and asked it he accepted and that he be relieved of his duties on Sept. 14, 1959.

It is therefore the order of the Court that Sheriff Smith's resignation be accepted, effective as of Sept. 14, 1959.

It is further ordered that Blan Greer's resignation as Tax Assessor & Collector be accepted and that Blan Greer be appointed as Sheriff of Sabine County in the place of Everett Smith effective as of Sept. 14, 1959, he being appointed to serve the unexpired term of Everett Smith.

The Court also orders that Miss Ternice Travis be appointed as Tax Assessor-Collector to serve the unexpired term of Blan Greer to be effective Sept. 14, 1959. The above mentioned orders were passed on a motion by W. T. Love and seconded by Earl Smith- All voted AYE.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
