

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session at its regular meeting place in Hemphill, Texas, on Jan. 11, 1960, with all members of the Court present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commr. Precinct #1, W. T. Love, Commr. Prect. #2, Paul Lout, Commr. Prect. #3, Earl Smith, Commr. Prect. #4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

In August 1959, the Texas Highway Department presented to Sabine County, through its Commissioner's Court a "Plan for Highway Development in the vicinity of McGee Bend Reservoir". The Sabine County Commissioner's Court understands that Federal Corps of Engineers concur in the approval of this plan.

Now, Sabine County Commissioners Court has heretofore approved the above mentioned plan of Highway Development and does now reiterate its approval of said plan.

Further, it has been brought to the attention of this Court that there is an effort being made to change the routing of Road #7 as shown on map of above mentioned plan. It is therefore, the purpose of this order to show that Sabine County Commissioner's Court opposes any effort to relocate Road #7 as any such relocation would constitute abandonment of some 5 miles of Sabine County's Farm-To-Market Road System.

On motion of Paul Lout and seconded by Earl Smith and unanimously voted, this Commissioner's Court stands firm on its approval of herein mentioned plan of Highway Development.

It is the order of the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, that from Jan. 1, 1960 to Jan. 1, 1961, the Precinct and County Officer's of Sabine County, shall continue to be paid on a Salary Basis, according to Article XVI, Section 61 of the Constitution of the State of Texas, as amended, and that the compensation allowed each precinct and county officer by the Court shall be paid in twelve monthly installments or as the Court may hereafter direct.
