On this the 22nd day of February, A. D. 1960, the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, in the office of the County Judge, Hemphill, Texas Texas, convened in regular session/with the following members present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge; H. W. Wright, Commissioner, Prec. #1, W. T.Love, Commissioner, Prec. #2, Paul Lout, Commissioner, Prec. #3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Prec. #4; and Kyle D. Walker, County Clerk of said court.

Commissioner W. T. Love, made a motion that the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

## RESOLUTION

Whereas, the City of Hemphill, Texas is in the process of negotiations for the building of a sewer system in the City of Hemphill, Texas, and has voted bonds to pay for a portion of said system and the County of Sabine is the owner of a system of sewer lines on the Courthouse Square, as well as a main discharge line leading in a Southwesterly direction across the Southwest corner of the Public Square and across a portion of block #19 of Hemphill, Texas and across a portion of block #20 of Hemphill, Texas, and the septic tank and outlets therefrom, located on said block #20 of Hemphill, Texas, and it is the desire of the City of Hemphill, Texas, that said sewer pipes and deptic tank as now being operated and obtained by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, be transferred to the City of Hemphill, Texas, to facilitate the completion of the negotiation by the City of Hemphill and its plans to build a sewer system in the City of Hemphill, Texas, and that it would be to the best interest of Sabine County, that such system owned by it as above set forth, be transferred to the City of Hemphill, Texas;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners Court in regular session, that Sabine County convey to the City of Hemphill, Texas, the aforementioned sewer facilities now owned by it."

The foregoing motion was seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith, and the resolution was adopted unanimously by the Court, and the County Judge and the County Clerk, were authorized and directed to execute the necessary transfer of said sewer facilities to the City of Hemphill, Texas.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by "The Minutes of Accounts Allowed".
