

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in Special session April 5, 1961 with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commr. Precinct #1, W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct #2, Paul Lout, Commissioner Precinct #3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct #4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

The purpose of the Special session was to canvass the School Consolidation and Bond Assumption returns. The returns of the election held at Bronson, Texas on April 1, 1961, for the purpose of Consolidating with Pineland Independent School District were as follows:
