

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in regular session in the regular meeting place in Hemphill, Sabine County, Texas, on January 8, 1962 with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, Paul Lout, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4 and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Upon a motion by Earl Smith, seconded by H. W. Wright, and all Commissioner's voted "Aye" Dr. G. C. Winslow was re-appointed County Health Officer of Sabine County for the year of 1962.

It is the order of the Commissioners that the following transfers of funds be made:

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been elected in Sabine County, separate persons for the offices of the District Clerk and of the County Clerk of Sabine County, Texas, due to the fact that the Federal Census for 1950 showed that Sabine County had in excess of 8,000 population; and

WHEREAS the 1960 Federal Census Reports that Sabine County had a population of 7,302, having fallen below 8,000 persons; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 20, of the Constitution of the State of Texas provides

for the election, in counties having a population of less than 8,000 persons, of a single clerk who shall perform the duties of District and County Clerks; and

WHEREAS, the Democratic Primary Elections are approaching and the date of February 5th, 1963 is the last day upon which candidates for District and County offices may file their applications for a place on the ballot for the Democratic Primary Elections to be held on May 5th and June 2nd, 1962, and it is necessary that this Court pass an order providing that a single clerk shall be elected in Sabine County who shall perform the duties of District Clerk and County Clerk:

UPON MOTION of Commissioner W. T. Love and seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith and carried by a vote of 4 to 0, it is ordered by The Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, that there be, in 1962, an election for a single clerk who shall perform the duties of both the District Clerk and the County Clerk of Sabine County, Texas.

DONE AND PASSED at a regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, held on the 8th day of January, 1962.

Upon a motion by Paul Lout and seconded by Earl Smith, and all four (4) Commissioners voted "Aye" that an order, ^{be passed} to go on a fee or salary basis for the year 1962 are as follows:
