executed on October 13, 1958, with Bill Ward Machinery Company and the matter of the additional and final installment of \$4000.00 which was due April 15, 1962, and which has not been paid.

Upon motion^{duly} made by Commissioner Earl Smith and seconded by Commissioner W. T. Love, and carried unanimously, it is ordered by the Court that First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, be authorized to carry said warrant dated January 27th, 1962, in the sum of \$4,830.60 against the Road and Bridge Fund of Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, until the 15th day of April, 1962, at an interest rate of five per cent from its date of acquisition by First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, and the Court agrees to retire said warrant on April 15, 1962; and it is further ordered by the Court that a warrant for \$4,000.00 be executed in favor of First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, payable April 15, 1963, to bear interest from date at the rate of five per cent per annum, to cover the installment on the above mentioned lease contract which will be payable April 15, 1963; and the Clerk is directed to advise Mr. Wise to forward the above named warrant for \$4,830.60 endorsed over to First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, without recourse, along with said lease contract transferring all proceeds therefrom without recourse, to First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, and upon receipt of such instruments by First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, the Clerk is authorized to deliver to First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas, said warrant for \$4000.00, to mature April 15, 1963, and to bear five per cent interest from date of issue and the Court pledges the payment of said warrants from the portion of the Road and Bridge Fund allotted to Commissioner, Precinct No. 1.

Minute Order

Upon motion by Earl Smith and seconded by H. W. Wright, all voted "Aye" that Sabine County, Texas, acting by and through its Commissioners Court, disclaim by written instrument all right, title and interest in and to the streets and alleys of the town of Brookeland, Sabine County, Texas, that lie between and are adjacent to Blocks numbered 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 on a^{Unrecorded and Undeveloped} plat of said town, below elevation 179.0 feet mean sea level, except the area of main street in said townsite; to the heirs of A. L. Black, Deceased; and that said county likewise disclaim to the United States of America, all right, title, and interest in and to the streets and alleys of Blocks numbered 1, 8, 9 and 13, of said townsite; it being understood that the heirs of A. L. Black, deceased, own all the said numbered blocks except Nos. 1, 8, 9 and 13; and it being further understood that no funds of Sabine County have ever been used to maintain and operate said streets and alleys for public use.

It was agreed by the Commissioners Court for Willard Neal to sell Poll Taxes in the City of Pineland, Texas.

All accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
