T. V. Parker presented a subdivision plot for 22 lots on 8.5 acres of the Haley Headright all within the city of Hemphill.


On motion by H. W. Wright and seconded by Earl Smith and was approved by unanimous vote.

The Court ordered the County Treasurer to divide the money received from the State for Lateral Road Fund, equally to the (4) four Commissioners precincts.

The County Treasurer is directed to transfer the full balance from all the Road Districts to the Right-of-way Fund.


The County Attorney is directed to proceed with Condemnation of W. A. Rogers ROW on Highway #87.


All accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
