

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in special meeting at the regular meeting place on Wednesday, March 20, 1963 with the following members present: C. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1; W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2; Paul Lout, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3; Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4; and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Mr. James R. Crowe, Sr. Res. Engineer and J. M. York of the Texas Highway Department, met with the Honorable Commissioners Court to discuss the 1964 Farm-to-market road allotment.

The resignation of W. J. Barlow as constable of Precinct No. 3 was read to the court. Upon a motion by W. T. Love, seconded by Earl Smith, the court unanimously voted to accept the resignation.

Upon a motion by H. W. Wright, seconded by Paul Lout, the court unanimously voted to accept the application of W. J. Barlow as Deputy Sheriff of Sabine County, Texas, effective March 12, 1963.

It was also voted to accept the application, and appoint Walter Smith, Constable of Precinct No. 3.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.
