

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in regular session at the regular meeting place May 13, 1963 with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, Paul Lout, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

Upon motion by Paul Lout, seconded by Earl Smith it was unanimously ordered that the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, make application to the State Department of Public Welfare for food commodities donated by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

It was further ordered that Lois Smith be appointed authorized Representative and is hereby given full responsibility and authority for all matters pertinent to the receipt, storage, and use of such food commodities, and the maintenance of all such records.

The following conditions for eligibility to receive Commodities by individuals or families were adopted by the Commissioner's Court:

All eligible applicants must be a Citizen of the United States and must have been a resident of the State of Texas for at least one year, and of the County of Sabine for at least six months immediately preceding the date of application. Commodities will be issued only to those individuals or families having facilities for preparing and serving meals.

The level of income and resources from all sources to be following in determining eligibility to receive commodities shall be as follows:

No. of Persons:	1	2	3	4-5	6-7	8-9	10 or more add
Income per month:	\$83.00	\$135.00	\$150.00	\$165.00	\$180.00	\$195.00	\$7.50 for each add. person.

The resources maximums set may be lower than those specified below, but no city or county plan will be approved which includes in the Standard of Eligibility resource maximums above the following figures:

One Person - \$ 300.00

Two Persons - \$ 450.00

Add \$50.00 for each additional person up to \$600.00. Recipients of old age assistance, aid to the blind, and aid to dependent children and their normal dependents are hereby declared to be eligible, on a blanket basis, to receive commodities, provided the other above conditions are not on an individual case basis. Also aid to the permanently and totally disabled. The term "Normal Dependent" may include any related person living with and dependent on the head of the household.

It was ordered by the Court that future money available for 1963 be allocated to the various County Precincts in the following proportions:

Precinct No. 1	33%	Precinct No. 3	25%
Precinct No. 2	21%	Precinct No. 4	21%

Upon a motion by Henry Wright, seconded by Paul Lout, all voted by aye.

The Court authorized payment for Right of Way from Road & Bridge tax fund.

Accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the court adjourned.
