

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in regular session at the regular meeting place, Monday, Aug. 12, 1963, with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, Paul Lout, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

A Motion was made by Paul Lout and seconded by Earl Smith that the Sabine County Commissioners' Court accept the provisions contained in Minute Order No. 53066 passed by the State Highway Commission on June 28, 1963, for the improvement by the Texas Highway Department of the roads described below and that Sabine County agrees to furnish all required right-of-way free of cost to the State:

Extending from U.S. Highway 96 South of Bronson

Southwest a distance of approximately 2.0 miles.

Vote on the motion was as follows:

Whereupon the motion was declared carried.

The State Board of County and District Road Indebtedness has informed the County Court that after the proper amounts have been withheld from the County Lateral Road Accounts, there will remain a balance of \$ .

It is therefore the order of the Commissioner's Court of this County that said

balance be forwarded to Sabine County when the funds are available for the use and benefit of County Lateral Road Accounts.

Accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the court adjourned.
