This is to advise you that in accordance with the provisions of Article 1433 of Vernon's Annotated Revised Civil Statutes, that the water supply corporation referred to above proposes to lay its pipes, mains and conductors and other fixtures for conducting water through, under, along, across and over the public roads in the vicinity of Bronson, Texas, as shown by the attached map which is, by reference, made a part hereof for all purposes.

Bronson Water Supply Corporation

The Bronson Water Supply Corporation is hereby authorized to lay its pipes, mains and conductors and other fixtures for conducting water through, under, along, across and over the public roads of the County of Sabine, State of Texas, at the places designated on the map attached hereto. It is understood between the Commissioners' Court and the said Corporation, that the Commissioners' Court may require such Corporation, at its own expense, to relocate its lines located on any county roads, so as to permit the widening or changing of traffic lanes, by giving thirty (30) days written notice to such Corporation and specifying the line or lines to be moved, and indicating the place on the new right-of-way where such line or lines may be placed.

All water lines which may be placed under this agreement shall be placed in accordance with regulations and requirements of the County Engineer and the State Highway Department.
