

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in regular session at the regular meeting place, Monday, April 27, 1964, with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, H. W. Wright, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, W. T. Love, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2, Paul Lout, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3, Earl Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4 and Kyle D. Walker, Clerk of the Court.

The County Treasurer is directed to transfer the proper amounts from R & B Special Account to Officers Salary Fund as per order on file.

The Treasurer is also directed to transfer from Jury Fund the amounts necessary to pay the salary & expense account of the District Court Reporter. He is also directed to transfer from Jury the amount the County pays the District Judge. Also he shall transfer from Jury the amount of the annual salary of the Secretary of District Attorney.

The County Treasurer is directed to transfer from General Fund to Salary the following: The Janitor's salary and the salary of Mrs. Lois Smith, Director of the Commodity Program.

The County Judge and County Treasurer are directed to buy for R & B Tax Fund from time to time in denominations of \$ 1000.00 from Permanent School Fund until all past due warrants are eliminated.

The Court Clerk is directed to deliver to the County Treasurer a copy of this order.

The above orders were made on a motion by Earl Smith and seconded by Paul Lout. All members voted aye.

The results of the election held April 25, 1964 concerning the Cattle Election at Brookeland in Election Precinct No. 3 were as follows: For the Stock Law 41 votes and Against the Stock Law 9 votes. This election was canvassed by the court today.

Accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
