
and O.A. Beauchamp, County Judge, being absent.

On a motion by Commissioner W.T. Love, seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith, with all Commissioners voting "Aye", the Commissioner's Court passed an order designating the First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas as County Depository for the ensuing years of 1965 and 1966.


