The election returns of a Trustee election held in West Sabine Independent School District and in Hemphill Independent School District on the 3rd day of April, 1965, were canvassed and found to be in order.

On a motion by Commissioner W. T. Love and seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith, with all Commissioners voting "Aye", the Court passed an order designating the Sheriff to supervise the Custodian in his official duties.

On a motion by Commissioner W. T. Love and seconded by Commissioner Earl Smith, with unanimous consent of all members present, the Commissioners' Court directs the County Treasurer to apportion the County's Road & Bridge Special to Commissioner's Precincts as follows:


Precinct #1	33%
Precinct #2	21%
Precinct #3	25%
Precinct #4	21%

and the County Clerk is directed to deliver to the County Treasurer a copy of this order.




Accounts were allowed and payable. There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
