The purpose of this Special session was to consider the Herbicide Law, the results being as follows:

WHEREAS, the control of brush is of major importance to Sabine County; and
WHEREAS, row crops in Sabine County are no longer grown in substantial numbers; and,
WHEREAS, the farmers of Sabine County, Texas, desire to control brush by the use of herbicides which is now restricted by the Herbicide Law, being H.B. 402, Acts 53rd. Legislature Regular Session, 1953, and that is the desire of the farmers in Sabine County to have Sabine County removed from the effect of said law;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that the Texas Department of Agriculture be notified that a hearing is desired in order to determine whether or not Sabine County will be removed from the effects of said Herbicide Law.
