The Court discussed Commodity Handbook Revision #12 dated November 10, 1965 to The Certificate of Compliance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Amendment to Agreement for Distribution of Use of Donated Commodities, but differed approval.

Upon motion of Commissioner, W.T. Love, and seconded by Commissioner, Paul Lout and with all members voting "AYE", \$1,000.00 will be transferred from O.S.F. to Precinct No. 1 to repay an old loan.

The Court voted unanimously to pay \$33.33 monthly to participate in expense account of the District Attorney.

The Court directed the County Treasurer to transfer \$2750.08 from Jury Fund to O.S.F., \$19,238.52 from Road & Bridge Special Fund to O.S.F. and \$2144.32 from P.I. Fund to O.S.F.

All accounts were allowed and made payable. There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
