




Earl Smith, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, being absent.

The Court met in special session for the purpose of considering a petition submitted to the Court on the 14th day of March, 1966 concerning the enforcement of a stock law in the Brookeland area.

Upon a motion by Commissioner W. T. Love and seconded by Commissioner Henry Wright, with all members voting "Aye", the Court appointed Benny Doyle Byley, Special Deputy Sheriff and Pound Master in the Brookeland area and more particularly described in a Petition for a Stock Law Election recorded in Volume P, Page 75 of Commissioner's Court Minutes of Sabine County, Texas.

Appointment of Benny Doyle Byley to become effective March 17, 1966 for a period of 60 days and at a salary of \$325.00 per month.
