Love that the Sabine County Commissioners' Court accept the provisions contained in Minute Order No. 57580 passed by the State Highway Commission on May 5, 1966, for the improvement by the Texas Highway Department of the roads described below and that Sabine County agrees to furnish all required right-of-way free of cost to the State:

From end of F. M. Road 2866, 5.0 miles Southwest of U. S. Highway 96, Southwest to end of proposed F. M. Road at San Augustine County, a distance of approximately 0.3 miles.

From end of F. M. Road 2971, 1.8 miles South of F. M. Road 83 in Hemphill, South a distance of approximately 0.8 miles.
