Attorney James Allen Payne appeared before the Court and presented the following petition.

THE STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF SABINE

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS! COURT OF SABINE COUNTY. TEXAS:

THE UNDERSIGNED 85 freeholders of the hereinafter described subdivision of said County, desiring to have an election called to enable the freeholders thereto to determine whether cattle, horses, mules, jacks, jennets and donkeys, shall be permitted to run at large in such subdivision, show this honorable court that no election has been held within such subdivision for such purpose within the twelve months prior to this date, that no such election has ever carried therein, and that they desire, and pray that such classes of animals shall not run at large in such subdivision and that this court order an election to be held therein on some stated day, according to the law, for the purpose of enabling the freeholders of such subdivision to determine whether cattle, horses, mules, jacks, jennets and donkeys shall be permitted to run at large within such subdivision, which subdivision has been heretofore defined by such Court and which is described and the boundaries thereof designated as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point where the West boundary line of the Sion Smith Survey crosses the Housen Bayou;

THENCE in a North Northeast direction with West line of Sion Smith Survey and James C. Boyd Survey, A-75, to the Southeast corner of the R. H. Travis Survey;

THENCE in Westerly direction, along the South line of the R. H. Travis Survey,

Abstract No..232, to the Southeast corner of the M. E. Griffin Survey, Abstract No. 320;

THENCE in Northeasterly direction along the East line of the said M. E. Griffin Survey to the Northeast corner of the said M. E. Griffin Survey and where it intersects with the South line of the C. Buckley Survey, Abstract No. 260;

THENCE in a Northwesterly direction along the South line of the C. Buckley Survey to the Southwest corner of the C. Buckley Survey;

THENCE NORTH with the West line of the C. Buckley Survey to the point where said West line crosses State Highway 184;

THENCE in an Easterly direction along State Highway 184, until it intersects with A Farm to Market Road 1592;

THENCE in Northwesterly direction along the said Farm to Market Road No. 1592, until it crosses Tebo Creek;

THENCE in an Easterly direction along Tebo Creek until it flows into PaloGaucho Creek or Bayou;

THENCE in an easterly direction along the North Bank of Palo Gaucho Creek or Bayou to intersection with State Highway 87 and continuing easterly along said Creek or Bayou to its intersection with the North line of the John S. Lane Survey;

THENCE EAST along the North line of said survey to the corner of the John S. Lane Survey;

THENCE SOUTH along the East line of the John S. Dane Survey to the Southeast corner of said survey and the Northeast corner of the Gustavus Hart Survey, Abstract No. 21;

THENCE SOUTH along East boundary line of the said Gustavus Hart Survey to the Southeast corner of said Survey;

THENCE WEST along the South line of the said Gustavus Hart Survey to the North East corner of the Thomas B. Watson Survey; Abstract No. 281;

THENCE SOUTH with the East line of the said Thomas B. Watson Survey to the Southeast corner of said Thomas B. Watson Survey;

THENCE WEST along the South line of the said Thomas B. Watson Survey to the North East corner of the W. A. Malin Survey, Abstract No. 278;

THENCE SOUTH with the East line of the said W. A. Malin Survey to the Southeast corner of said W. A. Malin Survey, which is also the Northeast corner of the small Henry Nichols Survey, Abst. No. 170;

THENCE SOUTH with the East line of said small Henry Nichols Survey to the Southeast corner of said small Henry Nichols Survey which is also the Northeast corner of the small John Clark Survey, Abstract No. 78;

THENCE SOUTH with the East line of the small John Clark Survey to the Southeest corner of said Small John Clark Survey;

THENCE WEST with the South line of the Small John Clark Survey to the North-west corner of the Henry Johnson Survey, Abstract No. 401;

THENCE SOUTH on the East line of the Henry Johnson Survey, Abst. No. 401, to the Southeast corner of the said Henry Johnson Survey, which is on the North line of the Henry Nichols League, Abstract No. 46;

THENCE EAST along North line of said Henry Nichols League to the Northeast corner of the said Henry Nichols League;

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THENCE SOUTH with the East line of the said Henry Nichols League until it crosses the Housen Bayou;

THENCE WEST with the South bank of the Housen Bayou to a point where said Housen Bayou crosses the West line of the Sion Smith League AND the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
