County and District Clerk, W. W. Cavender, recommended to the Court that Minnie Gooch be appointed Deputy County and Deputy District Clerk of Sabine County, Texas.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Paul Lout and seconded by Commissioner Henry Wright and by unanimous consent of the Court, Minnie Gooch was appointed Deputy County and District Clerk, Sabine County effective 16th day of April, 1967.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Paul Lout and seconded by Commissioner Henry Wright and with all members voting "AYE", the Court authorized Sheriff Blain Greer to purchase Radar Equipment for use in law enforcement.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Paul Lout and seconded by Commissioner Henry Wright and with all members voting "AYE", the Court authorized the City of Hemphill to widen Highway No. 83 by cutting off the sidewalk on the south side of the Courthouse square with the exception that no more than half of the sidewalk adjacent to the jail on the same side of the square will be removed.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Henry Wright and seconded by Commissioner Horace Wilburn, the Court authorized Commissioner Precinct No. 3 to advertise for bids on a loader.

The Court canvassed the County School Trustee Election as follows:
